PROSPECT PUBLIC LIBRARY INTERNET GUIDELINES AND PERMISSION FORM FOR CHILDREN AGES 10 to 17 years of age

Parents/Guardians of children aged 10-17 years are required to have parental permission to access the Internet in any or all capacities.

If a Parent/Guardian agrees to give a minor child permission to access the Internet at the Prospect Public Library, all parties are to be made aware that the library is not responsible for the content of the Internet, as it has no control over, nor can it monitor, computer activities or Internet sites upon which a minor may enter and participate.

Parents/Guardians of children ages 10 to 17 years of age are solely responsible for their children's use of the Internet. Note there is no adult supervision or filtering of Internet sites in the Computer Room at the Prospect Public Library. Additionally, Parents/Guardians will be held financially responsible should repairs be necessary due to inappropriate use of the Prospect Library computers.
